ground of the world-famous Austrian alpinist Hermann Buhl. The Nordkette Perspective Trail,

which has won several awards for its architecture, invites you to linger on the Seegrube with

various elements and platforms with a view over the Inn Valley.

The impressive experience at the viewing point, the 2300m high Hafelekar, is within everyone's

reach thanks to the direct connection to the city. Various well-developed hiking routes invite

you to explore the high alpine terrain. Nature lovers get their money's worth in the adjacent

Karwendel Nature Park with over 3000 animal species and more than 1305 different plant

species. It is not uncommon for guests to catch a glimpse of the otherwise shy wild animals on

the Nordkette.

Extended operating hours and happy hour

As the cable cars run one hour longer in the evening from June to September, guests can

avoid peak times and save money at the same time. The round trip to the TOP OF
